GLENELG maintained its tenuous grip on fifth spot with a hard-fought, five-point victory over a gritty Sturt at Unley yesterday.

The Tigers were forced to overcome a 17-point deficit in the final quarter to claim their eighth win of the season, to remain a game above Woodville-West Torrens on the ladder, with three rounds left.

Crows-listed Richard Tambling had a chance to end the match in a draw but his set shot from 35m after the final siren narrowly missed for a behind.

"We just needed the win, that is the bottom line," Glenelg coach Kris Massie said. "The side showed really good resilience skills. Again we did not start well but the resilience from the group - I'm really pleased for them."

"Every week is desperate. We just have to focus on getting better and improving. We are not talking finals. We have looked at the ladder but we are focused on improvement, our processes and development."

The Double Blues, already without ruckman Angus Kurtze, were forced to go into the contest without inspiring leader Jade Sheedy after he withdrew with a thigh injury.

But the home side regained hardnut Auden Riley from the Crows and his presence on the ball had a significant influence in the Double Blues building a 19-point buffer late in the opening quarter.

Sturt was the more threatening side early in the slippery, heavy conditions with its efficient ball movement through the corridor. Its tackling and defensive pressure also caused issues for the Tigers.

However, the Tigers opened the second quarter with more intensity and within five minutes they trailed by just a point after Jason Davenport nailed two goals simply by jamming the ball on to his boot in hope.

Late in the term, Kane Tenace was rewarded for his

persistence when he kicked a superb goal to give the visitors the lead.

The match became a tough slog after half-time as the two sides traded blows. It was not a pretty, skilful battle but it was a tight, intriguing affair between two committed outfits fighting for season survival.

After securing a handy buffer in the fourth quarter, the Double Blues were seemingly intent on protecting the advantage and they were hurt by crucial skill errors and turnovers.

It was the Tigers, with youngster Max Proud outstanding in defence and Jarryd Lyons getting his hands on plenty of possessions, who were prepared to take the game on with run and they responded to the challenge with the final three goals.

"The boys will be really gutted with that one," Sturt coach Seamus Maloney said. "They worked hard enough to win it."

"Glenelg (would) probably feel the same if they had lost. To go nearly three (goals) up midway through the last quarter and I thought there had been a lot of good, hard work all day."

"So it is gut-wrenching when we can't get over the line like that."
